

PATIENT ENROLLMENT PROCESS

for Minnesota's Medical Cannabis Program

STEP ONE



1

Patient identifies their qualifying medical condition.

Visit mn.gov/medicalcannabis to learn which medical conditions qualify.

STEP TWO



2

Patient finds health care practitioner who certifies condition.

For help finding one:

- Ask your medical team or advocacy groups that represent your condition.
- Search on the internet, including the websites for Minnesota's medical cannabis manufacturers.

STEP THREE



3

Patient completes enrollment application, provides proof of ID & pays fee within 90 days of certification.

The annual registration fee for a patient is \$200, which can be reduced to \$50 if proper medical assistance documentation is provided.

STEP FOUR



4

Patient receives approval email from the Office of Medical Cannabis.

Before you go to your Cannabis Patient Center:

- Schedule an appointment.
- Complete the Patient Self-Evaluation.

STEP FIVE



5

Patient or caregiver picks up medical cannabis at any Cannabis Patient Center in Minnesota.

Cannabis Patient Centers are located in: Blaine, Bloomington, Burnsville, Eagan, Hermantown, Hibbing, Minneapolis, Moorhead, Rochester, St. Cloud, St. Paul, Willmar and Woodbury.
