Due to the upcoming holidays, MnVFC and UUAV vaccine orders will not be processed Wednesday, Dec. 11 through Wednesday, Jan. 1, 2020. If you would like to receive vaccine shipments before to January, please submit them in MIIC by close of business on Tuesday, Dec. 10.

### Reminder: New MnVFC requirement in 2020

Beginning Jan. 1, 2020, you cannot store vaccine in the freezer section of a combination household storage unit. Refer to the “How to Manage the MnVFC Program” section of your policies and procedures manual for more information.

### Deadline passed for annual re-enrollment

The deadline to complete annual re-enrollment in MnVFC was Nov. 30. If you missed this deadline, complete the required re-enrollment materials as soon as possible to avoid suspension of ordering privileges. These are the requirements that were due:

- 2020 MnVFC Annual Report of Immunized Pediatric Patients.
- MnVFC annual online training.
- 2020 Replacement Method of Vaccine Management Agreement (Replacement method sites only).
