

Can I Get Free or Low-cost Shots?

UUAV PATIENT SELF-SCREENING FORM

The Uninsured and Underinsured Adult Vaccine (UUAV) program offers free or low-cost vaccines for Minnesota residents 19 years of age and older.

You are eligible for UUAV if:

You are uninsured. Meaning, you do not have private health insurance and are not covered by Medicare or a Minnesota Health Care Program (MHCP) like Medical Assistance (MA) or MinnesotaCare.

You are eligible for UUAV for select, non-covered vaccines if:

- You are insured but your insurance does not cover a specific vaccine.
- You are enrolled in Medicare, but the policy does not cover a specific vaccine.

Call the number on the back of your Medicare health insurance card to find out if specific vaccines are covered.

You are NOT eligible for UUAV if...

- You are privately insured, even if you have a large deductible or copay.
- You are enrolled in an MHCP like MA or MinnesotaCare.
- You are enrolled in a Medicare policy that covers the specific vaccine, even if you have a large deductible or copay.

You are only eligible for the specific vaccines your Medicare policy does not cover. Call the number on the back of your Medicare health insurance card for more specific information.
