

Promoting Immunization Quality Improvement

SUPPORTING IMMUNIZATION PROVIDERS

As immunization coverage rates throughout Minnesota remain lower than desired, providers continue to explore ways they can increase rates within their clinics and throughout their communities. The Minnesota Department of Health (MDH) Immunization Quality Improvement (QI) team is available for consultation and customized assistance to support providers in projects and activities aimed at increasing their organization's immunization coverage rates.

What is immunization quality improvement?

Immunization quality improvement (QI) is a term used to refer to any project or activity that promotes vaccination and/or a coordinated, supportive approach to immunization practices.

How can the QI team help you?

- Consult on new or existing quality improvement projects or plans.
- Assess current workflows to highlight strengths and offer suggestions on opportunities for process improvement.
- Share your clinic's current immunization rates based on data reported to the [Minnesota Immunization Information Connection \(MIIC\)](http://www.health.state.mn.us/people/immunize/miic) (www.health.state.mn.us/people/immunize/miic).
- Offer training on the use of MIIC functionality to support immunization activities.
- Provide technical assistance and resources pertaining to selected areas of focus, such as strengthening immunization communications or facilitating return to clinic.
- Connect your project team to additional MDH resources.
