## Component A: Quantitative Data Reporting

#### **Basic Aggregate Data**

- 2. Retention rates per location served
- 3. Total number of children screened
- 4. Total number of children who received any oral health services
- 5. Total number of children who received dental sealants
- 6. Total Number of children who received at least one dental sealant on a permanent molar by age (preferred) and grade
- 7. Number of teeth sealed
- 8. Number of screened children with untreated tooth decay
- 9. Number of screened children with treated tooth decay
- 10. Number of screened children referred for dental treatment
- 11. Number of screened children referred for dental treatment
- 12. Number of children who received fluoride varnish
- 13. Number of children who received oral health education
- 14. Number of oral health kits distributed

#### **Child Level Data**

- Age and grade
- Number of:
  - 1. Teeth sealed
  - 2. Molars sealed
  - 3. Teeth with treated decay
  - 4. Teeth with untreated decay
  - 5. Fluoride varnish application
  - 6. Oral health education
  - 7. Referral for dental treatment

Note: Past dental grantees who participated in the Open Dental "Data Query Project" should submit the child-level data by utilizing the customized query.
