


YOUR LIFE MATTERS

WHEN YOU BUY DRUGS ON THE STREET OR ONLINE:

- You don't know what you are getting
- The color and appearance doesn't tell you anything about what's in them
- Most or all drugs are unpredictable and adulterated (e.g., mixed, laced, contain multiple substances)

New syringes & equipment at no cost



Sharps containers and safe disposal of used syringes



HIV and Hepatitis C testing, education, and linkage to care



Naloxone kits & training




Overdose prevention education, including safer injection practices
