Information Notice 2021-01: Change in Radioactive Materials Fees

Subject: Change to Minnesota Radioactive Materials Fees

The Minnesota Department of Health (MDH) is issuing this Information Notice to inform licensees of the recent law changes in <u>Minnesota Statute 144.1205</u> which outlines the fees for radioactive material use. The 2021 Legislature authorized this change to be effective July 1, 2021.

Changes to the fee schedule are:

- Annual radioactive material license fees have increased 30% for licensees with up to four locations of use on one license.
- Annual license fee categories have been added for several license types with greater than three locations of use on one license. Licensees with 4-8 locations will have an additional 20% increase on the new base license fee. Those licensees with nine or more locations on one license will have a 40% increase on the new license base fee.
- License renewals will require an application fee.
- Initial applications and license renewal fees have increased 15%.
- Amendment fees are \$600.
- Reciprocity fees are \$2400.
- Annual General License Registration fees are \$450.
