

Families Served by Evidence-Based Home Visiting Models by County, 2021

Two data files are available for download from the <u>Family Home Visiting Reports</u> (https://www.health.state.mn.us/communities/fhv/reports.html) webpage:

- hennepin 2021

These files provide counts of families served by one of the following evidence-based home visiting models during Calendar Year 2021, as reported to the Information for Home Visiting Evaluation (IHVE) data system:

- Early Head Start
- Family Spirit
- Healthy Families America
- Maternal Early Childhood Sustained Home-visiting
- Nurse-Family Partnership
- Parents as Teachers

The file all_counties_2021 provides family counts for each county in Minnesota based on the Primary Caregiver's last reported county of residence. The file hennepin_2021 provides counts by Community Health Board for families in Hennepin County.

File Specifications

The file all counties 2021 has 19 columns:

Column Name	Description
county	Numeric code for each Minnesota county as assigned in IHVE (values 1 through 87)
county_name	Name of Minnesota county
monthly_avg_2021	The average monthly count of open families residing in this county during 2021. Each monthly count was calculated as the number of open Primary Caregivers on the last day of the month.
total_served_2021	The total number of open families residing in this county at any point during 2021.
age_19_and_under	Primary Caregiver age group 19 and under. Age is calculated as of the most recent visit date reported during 2021.
age_20_to_24	Primary Caregiver age group 20 to 24
age_25_to_29	Primary Caregiver age group 25 to 29
age_30_to_34	Primary Caregiver age group 30 to 34

age_35_and_over	Primary Caregiver age group 35 and older
race_aian	Primary Caregiver race category American Indian and Alaska Native. Caregivers who reported more than one race are included in each category reported; therefore the sum of counts across categories may be greater than the total reported for 2021. Those who declined to answer are not included.
race_asian	Primary Caregiver race category Asian
race_black	Primary Caregiver race category Black and African American
race_nhopi	Primary Caregiver race category Native Hawaiian and Other Pacific Islander
race_white	Primary Caregiver race category White
race_other	Primary Caregiver race category Another race not listed
ethnicity_hispanic	Primary Caregiver ethnicity category Hispanic and Latina/o. Primary Caregivers who reported more than one ethnicity are included in each category reported; therefore the sum of counts across categories may be greater than the total reported for 2021. Those who declined to answer are not included.
ethnicity_somali	Primary Caregiver ethnicity category Somali
ethnicity_hmong	Primary Caregiver ethnicity category Hmong
ethnicity_other	Primary Caregiver ethnicity category Another ethnicity not listed

The file hennepin_2021 has 18 columns. The first column (CHB_hennepin) provides the name of the Hennepin County Community Health Board (values: Bloom-Edina-Richfield, Hennepin, Minneapolis). The remaining columns are the same as in the file all_counties_2021, beginning with the column monthly avg 2021.

Data suppression: Non-zero cells less than 5 were suppressed and replaced by an asterisk (*) in the data files. Complementary suppression was also applied to prevent back-calculation of suppressed cells based on county or CHB totals.

Analysis Methods

Data from the IHVE data system as of 4/14/2022 was used for this analysis. Families that did not consent to sharing their data with MDH were not included in this analysis.

Families in Hennepin County were assigned to Community Health Boards based on zip code as follows:

NOTES - FAMILIES SERVED BY EBHV BY COUNTY 2021

Primary Caregivers were counted as a proxy for counting families. Primary Caregivers were deduplicated based on the provider agency and locally assigned participant ID; there may be duplicates if served by more than one provider agency during the reporting year. No restrictions based on the reported funding source or MDH grant were applied to this analysis.

Families were considered open in the FHV program as of a given month if they had one or more reported home visits on or before the last day of the month, and their closure date (if any) was on or after the last day of the month. Open families may not have had a home visit during the reporting month - their last visit may have been up to 6 months prior to the first day of the reporting month. If the most recent visit for a family was more than 6 months prior to the first day of the reporting month, that participant was considered to be closed as of the last day of the reporting month.
