EMPLOYEE ILLNESS DECISION GUIDE

Do you have vomiting and/or diarrhea?

DO NOT WORK

- Go home. Do not return to work for at least 24 hrs after symptoms end (72 hrs during an outbreak investigation)
- Report symptoms to person in charge
- Person in charge records symptoms on Employee Illness Log
- Person in charge notifies regulatory authority of employee diagnosed with Salmonella, Shigella, E. coli, norovirus or hepatitis A virus



Does someone in your household have vomiting and/or diarrhea?



- WORK WITH PRECAUTIONS
- Reinforce proper handwashing
- Avoid bare-hand contact with ready-to-eat foods or clean dishes
- Go home at first sign of vomiting and/or diarrhea



WORK WITH PRECAUTIONS

- Notify person in charge of sore throat and fever
- Reinforce proper handwashing
- Avoid bare-hand contact with ready-to-eat foods or clean dishes
- Go home at first sign of vomiting and/or diarrhea
