- [Deaf Mentor Family Program](#) update.
- EHDl Benchmarks discussion for “1-3-6” goals and possible addition of “9 year” goal. A workgroup will continue discussion on this.
- Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA) grant proposal. MDH has received a new cycle of federal funding to support EHDl. Activities include continued support for “1-3-6” goals, and a new initiative to expand hearing screening to age 3 years.
- Help Me Connect is coming, fall of 2020. This new extension of [Help Me Grow](#) will be a resource for all children, not just those in early intervention.
